Why You Should Join the “Oil Contract Renegotiation and Prosperity for All” Movement

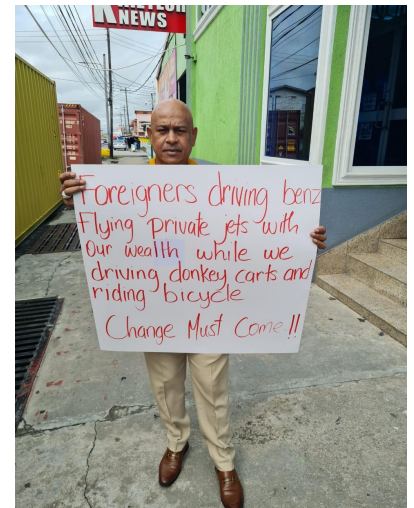
✔ **“Our Wealth, Our Country”** (OWOC) is formed to unify all those Guyanese who want “Prosperity for All,” and are enraged about the unfair, sellout oil contract that gives Guyana crumbs of 14.5% of the sales of all oil income, but gives away 85.5% to the oil operators (Exxon, CNOOC and HESS). It’s the worst oil contract in the whole world. How can we have such bad luck to have leaders who would sell us out like that? Even Suriname next door has a better contract. We want change!

✔ If the current contract is not changed, our working class will always be poor, because now the “rich are getting richer, and the poor are getting poorer.” We need the good life for all our rice and other farmers, fishermen, housewives, pensioners, sugar workers, small businesses, market vendors, retail sales people, civil servants, youths, students, single parents, nurses, policemen, security guards, those depending on public assistance and vulnerable populations. They all deserve prosperity now. It’s time for the ship to come in for the working people of Guyana. Despite much abundance of natural resources in Guyana (oil, gold, diamond, bauxite, manganese, precious stones, timber, fisheries, rice, sugar, coconuts, vegetables, ground provisions, agriculture, silica sand, sand, stone, etc.), Guyana has the lowest standard of living. We have the lowest currency of all CARICOM countries. This is a shame!

✔ The PNC gave away the store and the PPP which promised during the elections that everything in the oil contracts will be “reviewed and renegotiated” has not kept its promise. The PPP was telling the voters it would renegotiate and behind our backs was quietly telling Exxon bosses that they will not renegotiate. That was a promise made, promise not kept!

✔ Guyana’s oil belongs to the people of Guyana, not the Government or foreigners. It’s our wealth and our country. The Government is just a caretaker, and they must protect the national patrimony. This message is being repeated daily by a National

Hero, Mr. Glenn Lall and his newspaper the Kaieteur News, and the Kaieteur News Radio. With the PNC and PPP being on the same side with the oil companies against the interests of the people of Guyana, Mr. Lall and KN have been the loudest, strongest, most consistent voice fighting for the working people of Guyana. The spirit of Dr. Jagan, the fighter, can be seen in the advocacy of Mr. Lall who dedicates enormous resources to the cause of renegotiation of the oil contract.
